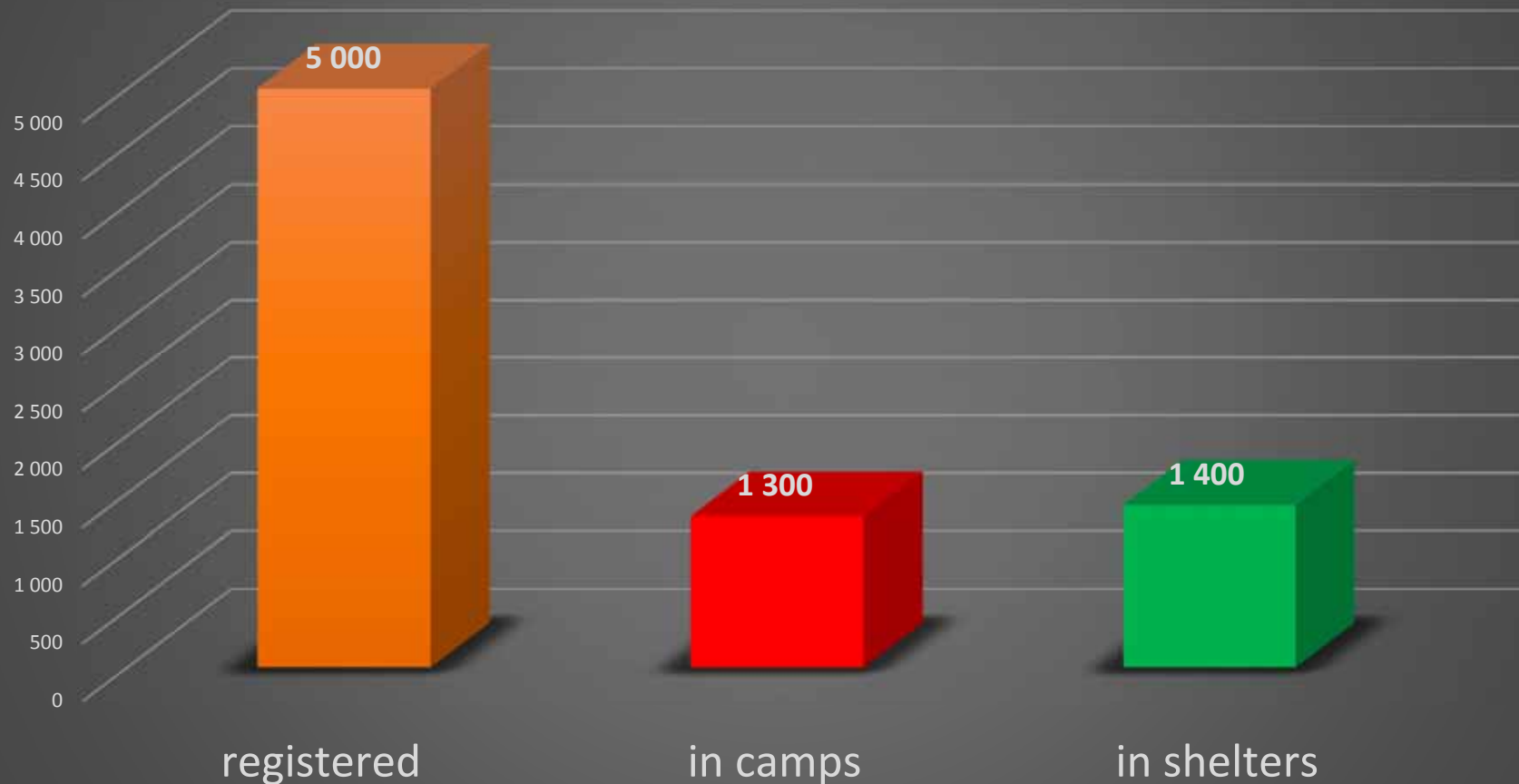

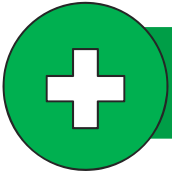

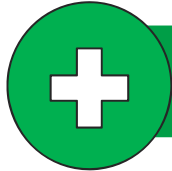
The majority of the children are still in SOS shelters

Eager to participate in sports and social activities

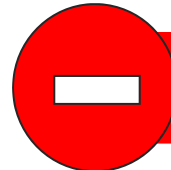

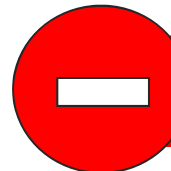

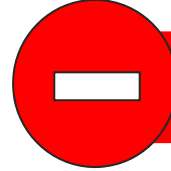

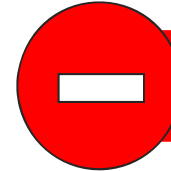
Traffickers have easy access in camps



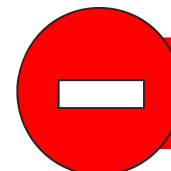
Children above 14 do not attend school



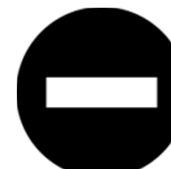
Unattended children tend to have criminal activity
